



## Animals of the Rainforest Project

- 8. Endangered Status
- 9. 5 Cool or Interesting Facts about the animal
- 10. Why should this animal be chosen for Zoo Atlanta?
- 11. What special considerations must the zoo know about before choosing this animal?

## Helpful Hints:

- 1. Complete Research first!!
- 2. Create 11 slides first and add layout designs.
- 3. Add all titles to slides.
- 4. ADD TEXT TO SLIDES BEFORE ADDING GRAPHICS AND ANIMATION!!!!!
- 5. After text is on all slides go back and add pictures, graphics, animation and sound.
- 6. SAVE YOUR PROJECT TO THE "W" DRIVE IN THE FOLDER: SILVERMAN RAINFOREST PROJECTS.
- 7. Ask before you shut down your computer the first day so I can make sure your project is saved in the correct location.
